HIV/AIDS Facts

- Young women and children are the most likely to be victims of HIV and AIDS.
- With proper health care, the risk of mother-to-child transmission during pregnancy and birth can be reduced to less than 2 percent; but sadly, few women have access to this care.
- There is no known cure for AIDS — a person must stay on antiretroviral therapy for life to reap benefits from the medication.
- Discrimination toward HIV and AIDS victims exists everywhere and plagues children as much as adults.
- Myths and stigmas lead to further spread of the disease and distrust of the people with the disease.
