



HomeWord Volunteer,

Thank you so much for taking your time to volunteer on behalf of Compassion for this HomeWord event. We are so grateful that you have chosen to take the time to invest in the ministry of Compassion.

Please arrive early to setup the Compassion table. If you do not see the Compassion display/materials in the meeting room, please check the venue's main office for a shipment from Compassion. You will find a box of Compassion materials/child packets, as well as a container that has a single pull-up display in it. You will need to set out and arrange the child packets on the table, and set up the pull-up behind or beside the table. Please confirm with the venue's main office that they will be open at the end of the event so that you can drop off our materials to be shipped out on the next business day (Compassion will schedule this through FedEx).

One of the items you will find in the box of materials is a DVD. This DVD will be used for the Compassion presentation. The seminar speaker should be onsite once you arrive, and you can give this DVD to him. It is really important to connect with the speaker before the event begins to make sure they are planning to show the Compassion DVD, and give an "ask" for child sponsorships. Ask if they would like a packet on hand to highlight during their presentation, then collect it at the conclusion.

After the event ends, please pack up the materials that need to be shipped back to Compassion, and have them labeled appropriately (extra labels are included in plastic pouch on outside of box). The Sponsorship Forms will be mailed back separately, as instructed on the large white return envelope. All of the materials can be placed at the reception area for FedEx pick-up.
