Give, Save, Spend Piggy Bank Craft

BEGIN TEACHING YOUR CHILD FROM AN EARLY AGE HOW TO SEPARATE HIS OR HER MONEY INTO CATEGORIES OF GIVE, SAVE AND SPEND.



Here are instructions for making a bank that will help illustrate this concept in a hands-on activity:

1. Connect three jelly jars (you can decorate them first, with paint or by decoupage, if you wish) with glass glue or double-sided adhesive dots. If you don't want to use glass, you could use powdered beverage containers or coffee cans.
2. Additionally secure containers with a large rubber band (or two, if your containers are tall).
3. If you'd like, replace the lid inserts with slotted ones, or make slots in your lid inserts.
4. Further decorate the jars if you wish.
5. Label your jars, "Spend," "Save," and "Give," respectively. A free printable you can use for labeling is on the next page, or have your child make his or her own with crayons and watercolor paint!
